

Since October 2013, NECAT has provided opportunity to chronically unemployed and underemployed adults. Our primary training center is located in the Newmarket District of Roxbury and in January 2018 we opened a satellite training site out of Everett. We offer 210 students each year the opportunity to complete our tuition-free 16-week Culinary Arts Job Training Program and are proud to report a 75% job placement rate for graduates, who are earning living wage salaries, with 74% achieving at least 3-month job retention.



### **Demographics**

**NECAT-Everett** students are primarily from Malden (42%) and Everett (26%), as well as Medford, Chelsea, Nahant, Winthrop, Revere and Stoneham.

**NECAT-Boston** students are primarily from Boston (23%), Dorchester (20%) and Roxbury (16%). Please note, most students with a Boston zip code live in a homeless shelter. The average age is 36, with 34% female. Other demographic data includes:

### Technical and Job Readiness Training

We deliver an engaging curriculum that teaches culinary theory, nutrition, food safety and sanitation, and advanced cooking and baking techniques. In addition, we coach students through the job search process, resume writing and interviewing, and provide job readiness and life skills training in the areas of conflict resolution, team work, communication and more.

# Individualized Support

NECAT partners with a growing network of social service agencies to provide students with a continuum of services. The goal is to help students address their barriers to stable employment before entering the workplace.

# Employment


Employer Partners help shape the curriculum, mentor students, provide culinary stages (working a shift as a form of interview) and permanent employment opportunities.




## Student Hourly Pay \$15.00 \$13.00 \$9.00 Pre-Program\* Post-Program
